### **Carpineto Dogajolo, Toscano Bianco, DOCG**

Carpineto winery was founded in 1967 in Tuscany, this amazing, White 'Super-Tuscan' produced from estate grown vineyards, planted after a careful study aimed at identifying the best environment to produce this wine. The hillside, dry-farmed vineyards are located within the Chianciano and Montepulciano (Siena) property. The grapes used in this white super Tuscan blend are Chardonnay, Grachetto and Sauvignon Blanc.

### **Surrau, Limizzani, Vermentino Di Gallura, Sardinia, DOCG**

Gallura, a land of granite rocks and mistral winds on the northern end of the island of Sardinia, is home to some of the finest Vermentino made. Limizzani is the name of a mystical site from the ancient Mediterranean civilizations that inhabited the region thousands of years ago. From grapes sourced across all the estate vineyards, Limizzani is a fresh and pure Vermentino that embodies the essence of Gallura

### **Podere Ruggeri Corsini, Barbera D Alba, DOC**

Did you know we have a very special connection with this winery, this was our very 1<sup>st</sup> wine dinner partner, that we did at Ragazza Di Bufalo in 2018, so it has a special place in our heart. Loredana and Nicola decided to move away from the big city and move to the countryside in Piedmonte and open a winery, they started with some classics from this region. It has a ruby-violet, red color, a rich and varied bouquet with fruit notes reminiscent of blackberries, cherries, strawberries and berry jam, along with spicy notes of cinnamon, vanilla and green pepper. Its deep, full and robust flavor softens the acidity typical of this variety. It can be aged in steel vats, in bottles or in wood.

### **Castorani, Montepulciano D'Abruzzo, Abruzzo Italy DOC**

Castorani, founded in 1793, in the beautiful region of Abruzzo, Italy, on the Central East Coast of Italy this wine is 100% Montepulciano, not to be confused with the town of Montepulciano the nose features intense ruby red fruits, which are balanced by savory notes of coffee, pepper and earth. The palate turns rich and bold darker fruit, but a lighter, almost candied cherry element persists, while firm tannins and a wave of acid accentuate an enduring earthiness, perfect pairing for pasta dishes

### **Camigliano, Brunello Di Montalcino (Bottle Only) DOCG**

Chef Steve personally visited this winery on his recent trip to Italy and fell in love with this winery, very small production, well cared for winery.

This wine is a Ruby red wine, tending to a very lively garnet. It has an intense and persistent, ample and ethereal scent. Small ripe red fruits are highlighted together with spicy notes. On the palate the tannins are balanced and soft with an excellent aromatic persistence.

**Brunello di Montalcino** is made from the Sangiovese grapes and is grown in the region of Tuscany. Flavors and aromas of red and black fruit with underlying vanilla, earth tones and spice hints.

## Get to Know Our Italian Wines

**Prosecco** is made from Glera grapes and is a dry sparkling style wine, from the town of prosecco in the Valdobbiadene hills in the Veneto region specifically, Italy's creation of a version of champagne and much cheaper.

**Pinot Grigio** is from the Veneto region in the northeast part of Italy, is a dry white wine grape, has a burst of lemon, lime, green apple and honeysuckle.

**Moscato** is the Italian word for the muscat family of grapes, and frequently refers to a lightly sparkling, low-alcohol sweet white wine. With flavors of citrus, stone fruit, and orange blossom.

**Soave-Garganega** is a dry white Italian wine from the Veneto region, principally around the city of Verona, Throughout the Soave production zone, Garganega is the principal grape variety, tastes of peach, honeydew, green apple, citrus and sweet marjoram.

**Amarone** Della Valpolicella is a rich dry red wine made from the partially dried Corvina grapes, baked on the roofs in the sunshine, Valpolicella is in the province of Verona, aromas of cherry, black fig and green peppercorns.

**Nebbiolo** is an Italian red wine grape variety predominantly associated with its native Piedmont region, where it grows. Nebbiolo produces lightly colored red wine. As they age, the wines take on a characteristic brick-orange hue at the rim of the glass and mature to reveal other aromas and flavors such as violets, tar, wild herbs, cherries, raspberries, truffles, tobacco, and prunes.

**Barbera** is a red Italian wine grape variety from the Piedmont region, considered the people's wine of consumption by the locals. Barbera is the third most-planted red grape variety in Italy. When young, the wines offer a very intense aroma of fresh red cherries and blackberries.

**Barolo** is often described as the "King of Wines" from being served to royalty. Barolo is made from Nebbiolo grapes and needs to be aged for at least 36 months after the harvest before release. Aromas and flavors of tar and rose, truffles, chocolate, eucalyptus and leather.

**Barbaresco** is an Italian wine made with the Nebbiolo grape. Barbaresco is produced in the Piedmont region in an area of the Langhe immediately to the east of Alba and specifically in the communes of Barbaresco village. Aromas and flavors of cherry, truffles, fennel and licorice.

**Sangiovese** is the most produced grape in Italy, Tuscany is the region it mostly grows in, but can be found all over Italy and now in the USA and Australia the backbone for many varieties of wines, Chianti, Brunello di Montalcino, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano. It has flavors and aromas of cherry, strawberry, dried herbs, balsamic vinegar and smoke.

**Chianti** is any wine produced with Sangiovese grapes that must come from the Chianti region of central Tuscany, Italy. It was historically associated with a squat bottle enclosed in a straw basket, called a *fiasco* (*Flask*), however, the *fiasco* is only used by a few makers of the wine these days as most Chianti is now bottled in more standard shaped wine bottles. Flavors and aromas of cherry, strawberry, dried herbs, balsamic vinegar and smoke.

**Brunello di Montalcino** made from the Sangiovese grapes and is grown in the region of Tuscany. Flavors and aromas of red and black fruit with underlying vanilla, earth tones and spice hints.
